## School Based Clubs

### Semester 1 Registration

Club registration and payment have been combined into one easy step using School Pay.

- Log in to your student's School Pay account and select the club you prefer
- If you have more than 1 child, please register for their clubs individually under their school pay account/name
- Please be aware of grade level and day
- no refunds will be given (unless student is selected for tutoring, a competitive team or organization and the days conflict)
- If you receive a tutoring invitation, do not select a club that is on the same day.
- Registration will be first come first serve. (If a club is no longer visible, it is full.)
- Registration will close on August 29th
- Clubs cost \$5

**\*\*Students may only register for ONE SCHOOL-BASED CLUB\*\***

*(This does not include Competitive Teams, Organizations, or Vendor Clubs)*

- Tutoring always takes priority over clubs.
- Be sure to look at the After School Activity Schedule if you think your student may require tutoring or receive a tutoring invite.
- Outside vendor club registration and payment are separate from RCSA Intracoastal.
- Any questions regarding outside vendor club registration and payment should be directly communicated with the vendor.

#### FAQs for Club Registration

**Q: When does registration open?**

A: August 25 at 10 AM via SchoolPay Link

**Q: When does registration close?**

A: August 29 at 4 PM

**Q: Do I have to have a SchoolPay account to register my student, or can I check out as a guest?**

A: No, you may check out as a guest. However, it is recommended that you have a SchoolPay account to register for school-based clubs. Please see the video for step-by-step instructions on how to create a SchoolPay account and manage multiple children.

**Q: Am I able to register my child for more than one after-school-based club?**

A: No, students may register for **only one** school-based club.

**Q: Is there a registration fee?**

A: Yes, the registration fee covers supplies and materials

**Q: How will I know if a club is full?**

A: When the link loads, it will say: Item Unavailable.

**Q: If a club is full, can I get my student on a waitlist?**

A: No, there will not be a waitlist for any of our school-based clubs.

**Q: Can I get a refund if I register my student for a school-based club and they are requested to come to tutoring? Can I register for another club?**

A: Yes, a refund will be issued as tutoring takes priority over clubs. Please email [hbaktir@rivercityscience.org](mailto:hbaktir@rivercityscience.org) for a refund. Academics are of the utmost importance, so you may register your child for a school-based club the following semester.

**Q: If I register my child for a school-based club and they change their mind, can I register for another club?**

A: No, please review the After School Activity schedule carefully before making your selection. Please pay close attention to the grade level requirements for each club. **No refunds will be given.**



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**Q: Can my student participate in vendor and school-based clubs?**

A: Yes! We highly encourage students to register for vendor clubs. Just make sure to check the After-School Activity schedule for any conflicts.

**Q: Can my student participate in Academic/Competition Teams, Organizations, and register for a school-based club?**

A: Yes, students may participate in one school-based club along with whatever other organizations and academic teams they applied for and were accepted. Please be sure to check the After School Activity Schedule carefully before making your school-based club selection.

**Q: My student was selected to be in an organization and/or Academic team on the same day as their school-based club selection. Can I get a refund?**

A: Yes, please contact [hbaktir@rivercityscience.org](mailto:hbaktir@rivercityscience.org) for a refund. Your student may register for a different club next semester if they would like.

**Q: How can I confirm that my student is registered?**

A: School Pay will issue a receipt upon registration. This will serve as confirmation.
